- (b) "Lord, don't you care that **my sister** has left me to do all the work by myself? Tell her to come and help me!"
(Luke 10:40b)
- (i) Who said these words? [1]
 - (ii) Name the village where this incident occurred. [1]
 - (iii) What was '**my sister**' doing? [1]
 - (iv) What was Jesus' reply to the speaker? [2]
- (c) There was a man named Joseph from Arimathea, a town in Judea. He was a good and honourable man, who was ...
(Luke 23:50-51a)
- (i) What else are we told about Joseph of Arimathea? [2]
 - (ii) What did he do after Jesus had died on the Cross? [3]

- (i) What had happened in Antioch that made the Church send Barnabas there? [1]
 - (ii) Why do you think Barnabas was chosen to go? [1]
 - (iii) What did Barnabas do there? [1]
 - (iv) When the work became too much for him, what did Barnabas do? [1]
 - (v) What distinguishing thing happened there at Antioch as a result? [1]
- (b) About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening to them. Suddenly there was a violent earthquake, which shook the prison to its foundations. At once all the doors opened, and the chains fell off all the prisoners.
(Acts 16:25-26)
- (i) In which city did this happen? [1]
 - (ii) What did the jailer do when he woke up? [1]
 - (iii) What happened after that? [3]

- (c) *On the following day we left and arrived in Caesarea. There we stayed at the house of Philip the evangelist, one of the seven men who had been chosen as helpers in Jerusalem.
